

PROFESSIONAL PROFILE

A highly qualified and experienced dance educator and embodied historian. Moncell is an Associate professor of practices at University of Southern California Glorya Kaufman International School of Dance., specializing in pedagogical practices that provide a cultural/historical context in Afro-diasporic spiritual and social dance formations Moncell has consumed volumes of scholarly and popular literature in relation to African American vernacular dance forms, in particular, and general dance studies. Moncell has been teaching for 24 years. He has retained a 7-year adjunct professor position at Drexel University until he was accepted into an MA program in 2010 at Roehampton University in the UK, before Drexel Moncell held an appointment as senior lecturer of Hip-Hop at University of the Arts in Philadelphia. Moncell served two years on faculty at Yale (School of Drama) teaching the MFA students, spent five (5) years teaching Wesleyan University in Connecticut and one semester at Bennington College in Vermont, two years at The New School, one semester at Ursinus and Montgomery Community College. He was the first to introduce hip hop into the aforementioned Universities. And held guest residencies, lectures, and classes include CU Irvine, UCLA, Princeton, MCCC, Bucknell University, University of Bogota, and University of Buffalo.

Moncell latest work Beginning Hip Hop Dance is an Interactive Dance Series published by Human Kinetics. Currently he is doing research for his book Our Intangible Roots: The Culture, the Dance and the People. He. Developed an on-line hip hop course for NDEO and is working on a new documentary about the Dances that America made up and the Dance that Made America.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT AND QUALIFICATIONS

Moncell began dance training learning social dances of the 50's 60's and 70's from his mother, cousins, recording artist Rufus Thomas, and grew up learning the popular dances of the 70's and 80's. Well versed in popular social dance styles and techniques from early 20th Century to Current, Moncell has spent the past 20 years receiving personal training from 4 members of the original group the Lockers, The Electric Boogaloos, members of Rocksteady Crew, original soul train dancer Tyrone Proctor, Hip-Hop choreographer and pioneer Buddha Stretch, the late ambassador of Lindy-Hop Frankie Manning, toured and trained 10 years with Rennie Harris and Mop-Top music & movement. Apart from social dance practices Moncell independently study's Anthropology, Rhythmic Analysis, Neuropsychology, Anatomy, Ethnomusicology, Africana Studies.
